City Council Meeting 8:00 pm

The Pledge of Allegiance was repeated, and a prayer was given by Raymonda Furness

Shayne Hansen made a motion to accept the minutes for June 5, 2025, Council meeting. Brett Leavitt seconded. All voted in the affirmative.

Shayne Hansen made a motion to pay the bills submitted for July 2025, Raymonda Furness seconded. All voted in the affirmative.

Paul Sorenson from Fibercom spoke to the Council about installing fiberoptic cable in the city. Fibercom has signed with the City of Teton and would like to move forward with City of Newdale. IT Underground from Salt Lake City would be doing the work and could install this fall. The work will take about a month to complete. Brett Leavitt made a motion to move forward with the Fibercom agreement, Kevin VanWagner seconded the motion. All voted affirmatively. Mayor Stevens signed the agreement.

Dal Schwendiman gave the Public Works report. We have a valve at the water tank that is not working properly. Kolby Cazier came out and checked it out. It looks like the old control board is not working properly. We will order a new one.

Chad Stevens discussed that Mr. Dyer is working on the Transportation Study which must be in place before we can apply for any grants. Shayne Hansen made a motion to readopt the current Transportation Planning Study with the addendum to bring it up to date. Raymonda seconded. All voted in the affirmative.

Shayne Hansen discussed selling our surplus items, Mack truck, the sand spreader, extra lift station pumps. We will get some pictures and advertise them on Marketplace and other spots.

Raymonda Furness discussed the Fireworks will be held on July 11th. We will have Jenke family playing trumpets, Star Spangled Banner.

Raymonda Furness asked about fixing up the parking lot in front of the city building.

Chad Stevens spoke about the quote to resurface the tennis court and paint for a pickle ball court. The Council picked green samples for the paint.

The Council discussed the water problem at the post office. We have no answer from Edgington's yet.

The Council worked on the Tentative Budget. Shayne Hansen made a motion to adopt the tentative budget for fiscal year 2025-2026 and have it published for the Public Hearing. Raymonda Furness seconded. All voted in the affirmative.

Shayne Hansen made a motion to adjourn, Brett Leavitt seconded. All voted in the affirmative. The meeting adjourned at 10:00 pm.
